

RESOLUTION NO. 4 OF 2014

SETTING A DATE FOR THE REFERENDUM ON DISSOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS a petition was filed on April 2, 2014 for the purpose of forcing a referendum on a proposal to dissolve and terminate the Village of Salem; and

WHEREAS the 116 signatures on the petition, representing more than 20 percent of Village electors, were certified by the Village Clerk on April 7, 2014, and the contact person representing petitioners notified of the certification on April 18, 2014; and


