

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Salem was held on Tuesday, June 2, 2015 in the Village office. Present were Mayor Sonia Trulli and Trustees Paul Kobyluch and Jim Bain. Also present were Town Supervisor Seth Pitts and Councilman Bruce Ferguson.

The purpose of the meeting was to appoint the Town Council as successor testamentary trustees of the Benjamin Bancroft Trust. The Board of Trustees of the Bancroft Public Library have already voted to re-charter as a Town Library when the Village dissolves, and have expressed their desire that trusteeship be passed from the Village to the Town. Final appointment will come from the Washington County Surrogate's Court.

Paul Kobyluch made a motion, Jim Bain seconded, to appoint the Town Council of the Town of Salem as Trustees of the Bancroft Trust, which contains the building at 181 S. Main Street, Salem, and which supports the Bancroft Public Library housed there. All were in favor and the motion was carried.
