

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Salem was held on Wednesday, March 26, 2014 in the Village office. Present were Mayor Marcus Blanck and Trustees Mark Eastman, John Boyce, and Tina Fleming. The purpose of the meeting was to present and review the tentative 2014-2015 budget.

Discussion was had and the budget was reviewed.

The names of the Trustees on the Bancroft Public Library Board were presented for approval by the Village Board: Sandy McClellan, Sarah Wohlleb, Linda Lewis, Kim Erbe, Sarah Winslow, and Catherine Crank. Tina Fleming made a motion, Mark Eastman seconded, to approve the trustees presented. All were in favor and the motion was carried.

Three quotes were presented by the Water Department for inspecting and cleaning the three wells, along with the Water Operator's recommendation. After discussion, John Boyce made a motion, Mark Eastman seconded, to approve MJR for the work, as per the Water Operator's recommendation. All were in favor and the motion was carried.

A local law authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law Section 3-C was proposed and a public hearing set for April 2, 2014 during the regular meeting. This tax-cap override legislation was proposed in order to absorb the transfer of function savings established by the Office of the State Comptroller, caused by the SVFD, Inc. becoming independent.
